Any references used in creating the document should be included for example, the textbook, the lab notes... etc. This includes any images used.

5 points : Format/Equations/References (1 point for including this sheet with signature)

Did you follow the required format?

Did you include proper equations and defined all symbols?

Do your calculations have proper units and significant figures?

Did you include proper references?

5 points : Grammar/Syntax

Did you spell check the document?

Did you write in complete sentences, and use proper punctuation?

Does what you wrote come close to English?

5 points: Description of the objective and experiment (this may mix with the assignment answers)

Did you clearly explain the objective of the experiment?

Did you provide enough detail to explain the experiment?

Is it clear how you obtained your data?

5 points: Answers to assignment questions.
